NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2. The International J/70 Class Rules will apply.
- 1.3. The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located on the east porch of the FWBC Clubhouse.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the J/70 Class.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form found <https://www.regattatoolbox.com/eventDetails?eventID=dDhXcM2mKr> or by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to Fort Worth Boat Club, 10000 Boat Club Road, Fort Worth, Texas 76179 by March 24, 2017.
- 2.3. Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: a late entry fee and an onsite entry fee will be imposed according to the schedule outlined below in Section 3, FEES.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee will be ninety dollars (\$90).
- 3.2. A late entry fee of thirty dollars (\$30) will apply to all entries received after 1700, March 24 2017. This fee is cumulative to the entry fee and results in a total entry fee of one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120).
- 3.3. An additional onsite entry fee of twenty dollars (\$20) will apply to all entries received after 1700, April 28 2017. This fee is cumulative to the entry fee, and the late entry fee and results in a total entry fee of one hundred forty dollars (\$140).
- 3.4. NOTE: The late entry fee and the onsite entry fee are imposed to encourage early entry in the event, and can be avoided by completing registration before 1700 March 24, 2017.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Registration: Friday, April 28 2017 from 1700 to 2000; Saturday, April 29 2017 from 0800 to 0900.
- 4.2. Dates of racing: Saturday & Sunday, April 29-30 2017
- 4.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1000. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 0930.
- 4.4. On the last day of scheduled racing no warning signal will be made after 1300.
- 4.5. The regatta schedule is summarized as follows:

Friday	1700-2000	Registration available on the FWBC Premises
Saturday	0900	Skippers Meeting
	1000	Warning Signal for first race, additional races to follow
Sunday	0930	Warning Signal for first race, additional races to follow
	1300	No race to be started after 1300
	1500	Awards Presentation & Regatta Closing

5. MEASUREMENT

- 5.1. All boats and sails may be subject to measurement to ensure compliance with RRS 78.1 and the International J/70 Class Rules.

6. SCORING

- 6.1. Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series/regatta.
- 6.2. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 6.3. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst race.

7. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 7.1. All boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 8.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. Prizes will be given to the top three (3) finishing boats.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY



- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

11. INSURANCE

- 11.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
